2. Product Overview


By connecting a Linear Gage to this product, incorporating it into your equipment and supplying air, it is possible to automate Linear Gage measurement operation.

Linear Gages that can be connected to this product are as follows.

- LG100 Series (types with a measurement range of 25 mm or 50 mm)
- LGF Series (types with a measurement range of 25 mm or 50 mm)
- LGD Series (types with a measurement range of 25 mm or 50 mm)


The illustration below shows attachment to a Linear Gage with standard accessories and option parts

5. Attachment Procedure


After attaching the extension rod to the Linear Gage, attach the Linear Gage to this product.

5.1. Extension Rod Attachment

NOTICE Shows risks that could result in property damage.


To avoid malfunction or damage to the Linear Gage, be sure to use the contact point replacement key spanner that is provided with the Linear Gage when replacing the Linear Gage contact point. See the Linear Gage User's Manual for details.

- 1 Fit the provided contact point replacement key spanner to the spanner catches (two sides) at the tip of the plunger and hold the spanner to prevent the plunger from turning.
- 2 To prevent damage to the contact point, cover it with soft cloth and arip with pliers to remove it.
- 3 Insert the threaded end of the extension rod into the hole that formerly held the contact point and turn the extension rod to affix it.
- 4 Reversing the procedure used to remove the contact point, screw it into the end of the extension rod and tighten it securely.




5.2. Linear Gage Attachment

- 1 Hang the provided guide on the product's guide hook.
- 2 Set the Linear Gage into the hole in the mounting fixture of this product, pass the contact point through the round hole in the guide, and then attach the guide fastening washer and the guide O-ring fastener in that order.



- 3 Press the Linear Gage into position, then tighten the hex socket head cap screw in the mounting fixture to temporarily immobilize the stem of the Linear Gage.
- 4 With the contact point pushed in (to its upper limit), adjust the position of the Linear Gage so that there is a gap (about 0.5 mm) between the guide and the hook (to prevent any load from being applied to the Linear Gage when the air cylinder rises), and then fasten the Linear Gage by tightening the hex socket head cap screw.



5 Verify plunger movement as described in "6. Operation Speed Adjustment".

Tips


Over-tightening the hex socket head cap screw will impair movement of the Linear Gage plunger.

6. Operation Speed Adjustment

Shows risks that could result in property damage.

Over-speed errors will occur if operation speed is too fast. Excessive speed can also harm Linear Gage or workpiece.

After attaching the air supply hose, modify the air flow volume with the product's speed controller to adjust operation speed of the air cylinder. Lift the speed controller to unlock it (Figure A). Turn the knob to adjust operation speed, and then re-lock the speed controller. To increase operation speed, turn the knob counterclockwise, or to reduce operation speed, turn it clockwise (Figure **B**). Speed controller adjustment is only possible with the contact point is descending (when air flow is ON).



+: Increase operation speed -: Reduce operation speed

Tips

- · An air supply hose must be provided by the customer.
- If overspeed errors occur, adjust the air pressure using a pressure regulator or adjust the flow rate with the speed controller.

7. Auto Switch Attachment

An auto switch can be attached to this product.

The supported auto switch is the SMC auto switch CDJ2 Series with an inner tube diameter of 16 mm with a band attachment.

The auto switch must be provided by the customer.
